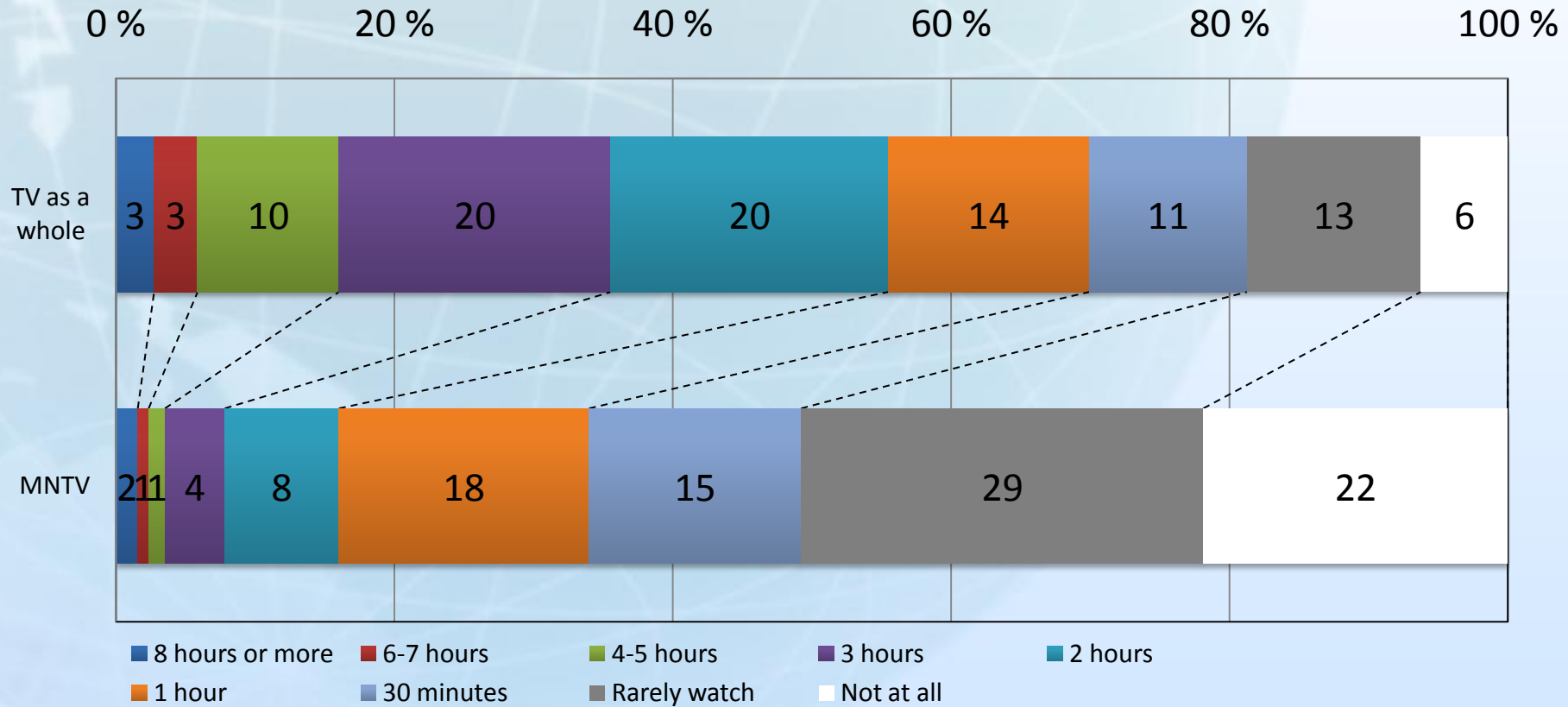


# Survey Results

# How Many Hours Do You Watch TV?

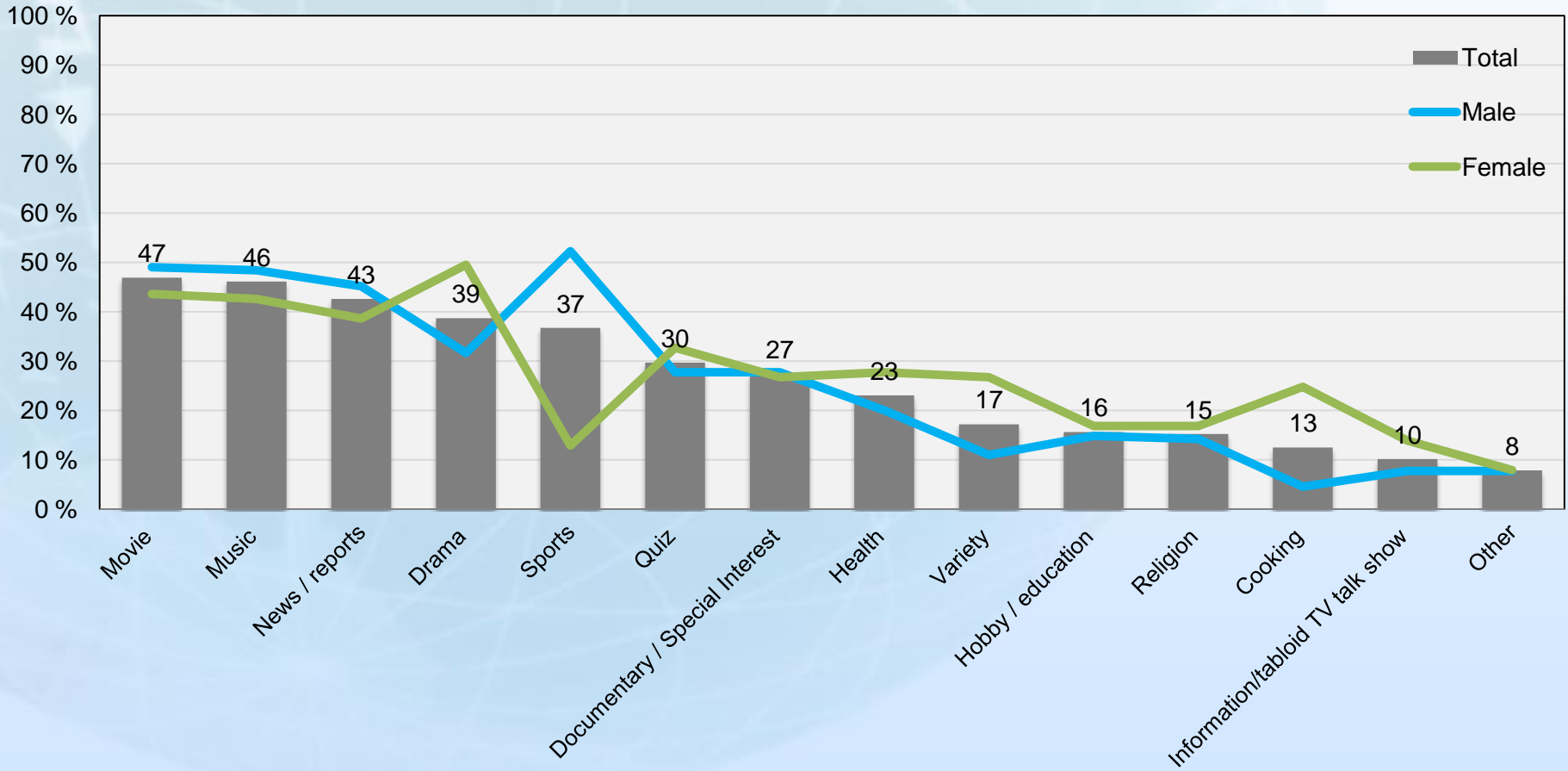
Many people watch TV for 2–3 hours per day on average. Not many people watch MNTV (Myanmar National Television), which runs the Japanese drama series.

**VARIETY and COOKING hold high popularity for women.**

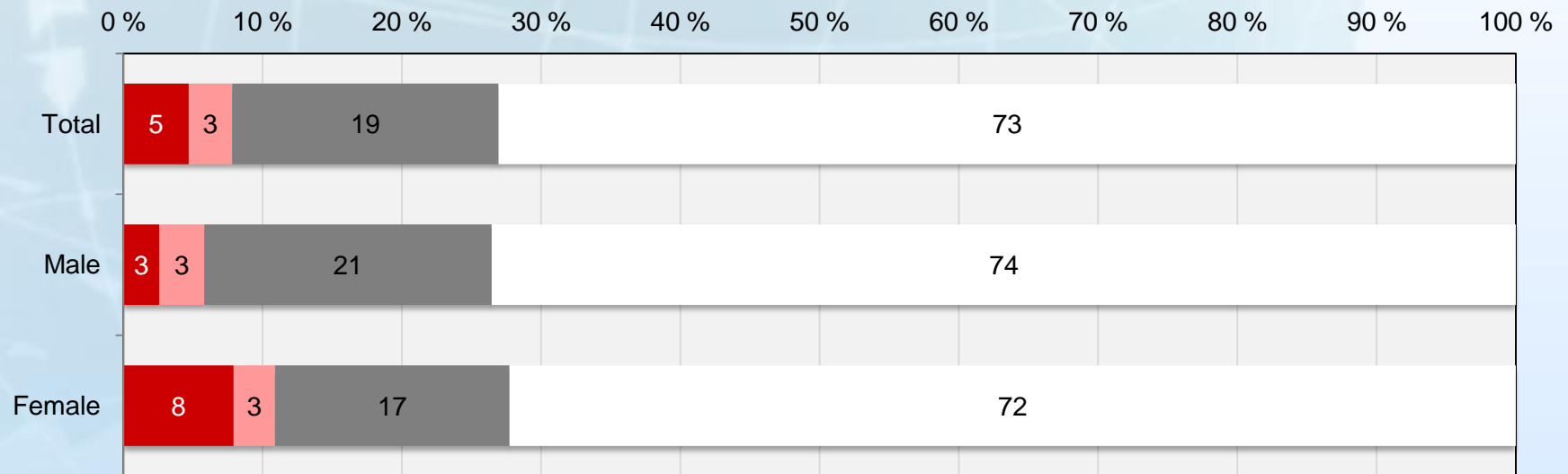
**Q** What TV shows do you usually watch? (MA)



# Knowledge / Viewing Experience of "Carnation" Broadcast

More than 70% of both men and women "Do not know the broadcast" of "Carnation" now on air in Myanmar.  
High rate of 8% women "are watching".

Do you know that? (SA)

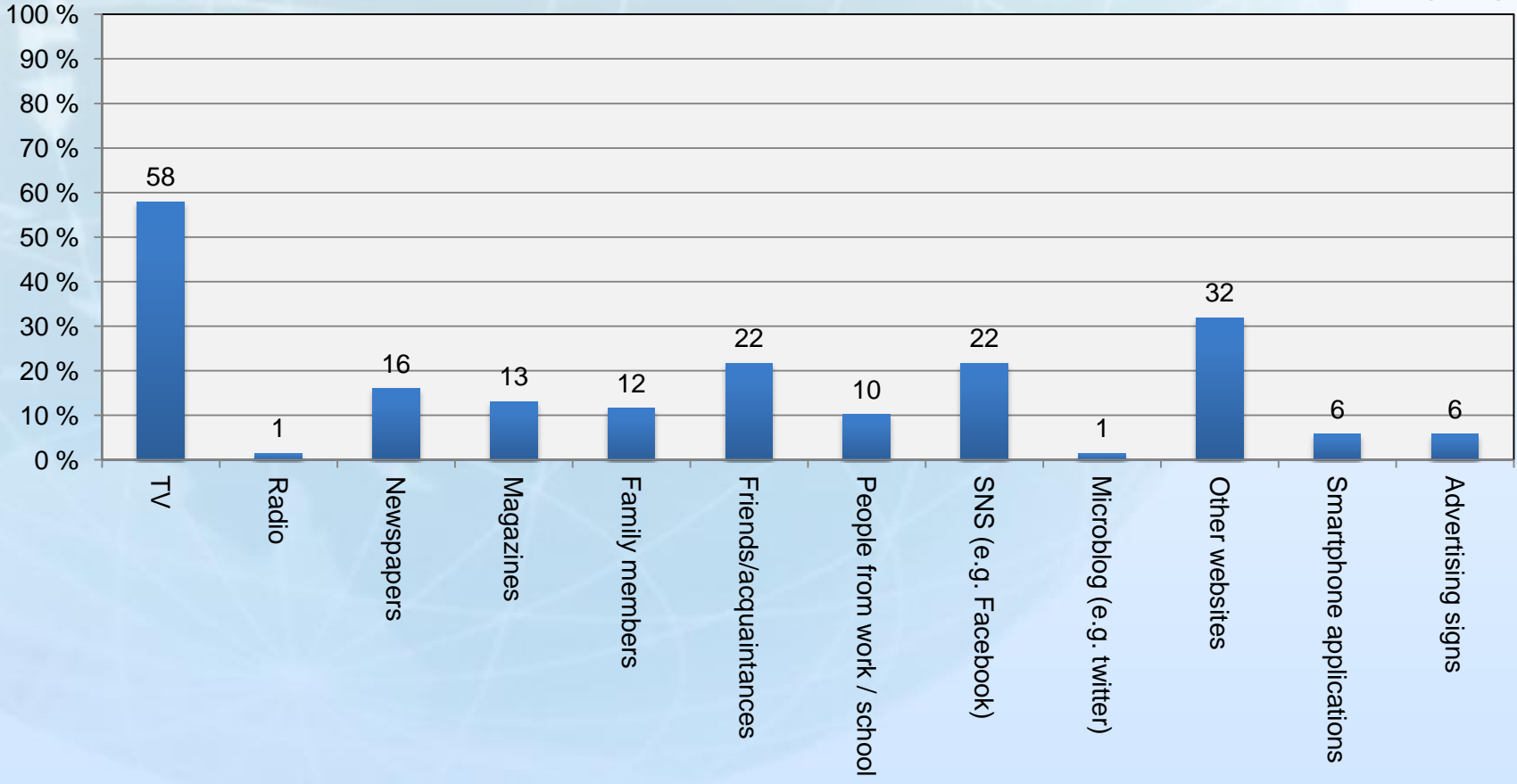

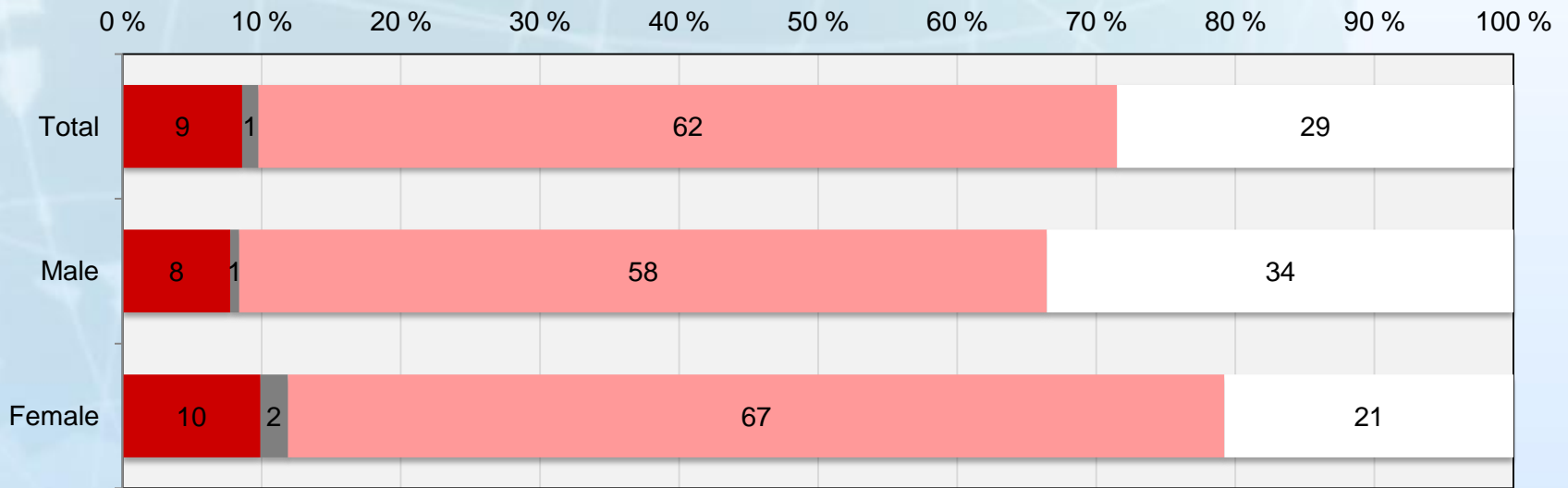
**Watched the show as I like

 High ratio of 80% women and nearly 70% men like to watch it.

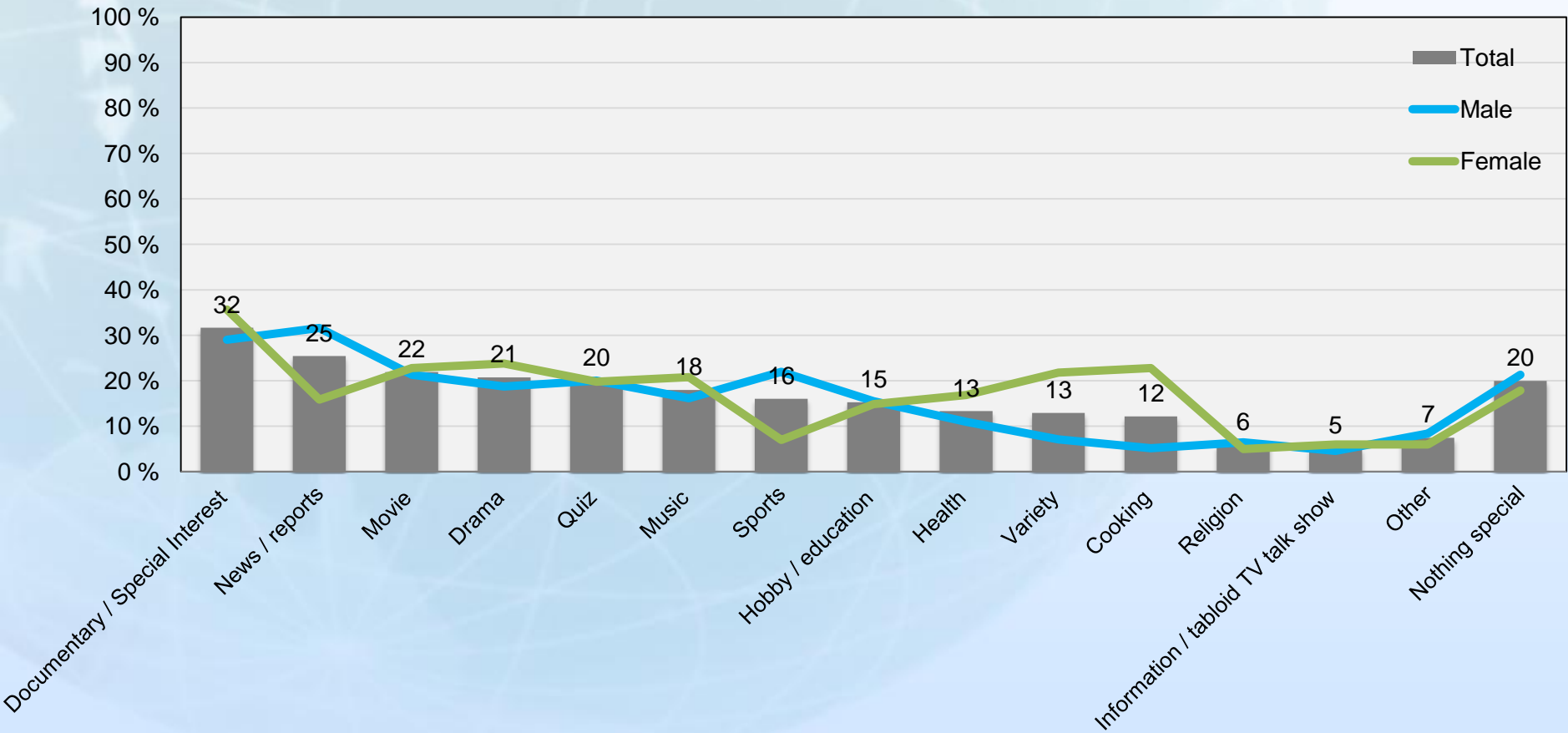


- I know the show and like to watch it.

# Japanese TV Shows You Would Like to Watch

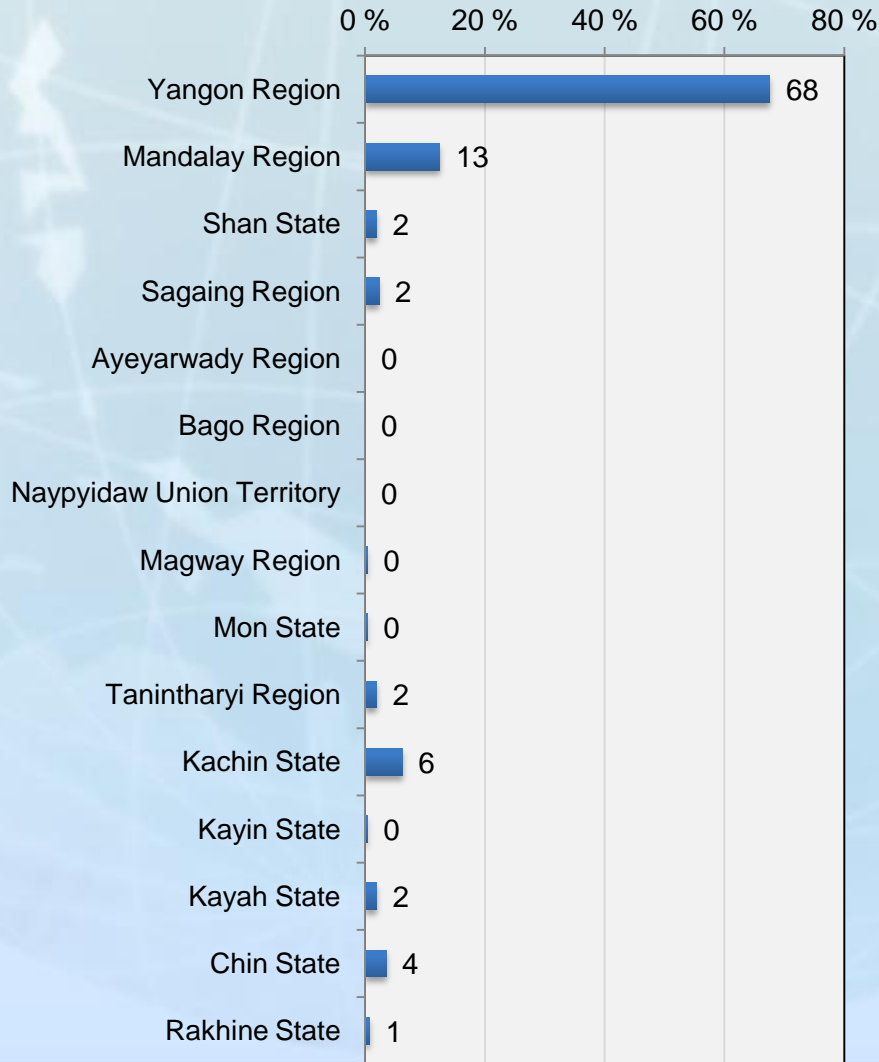
**DOCUMENTARY / SPECIAL INTEREST** is most liked to watch by both men and women.

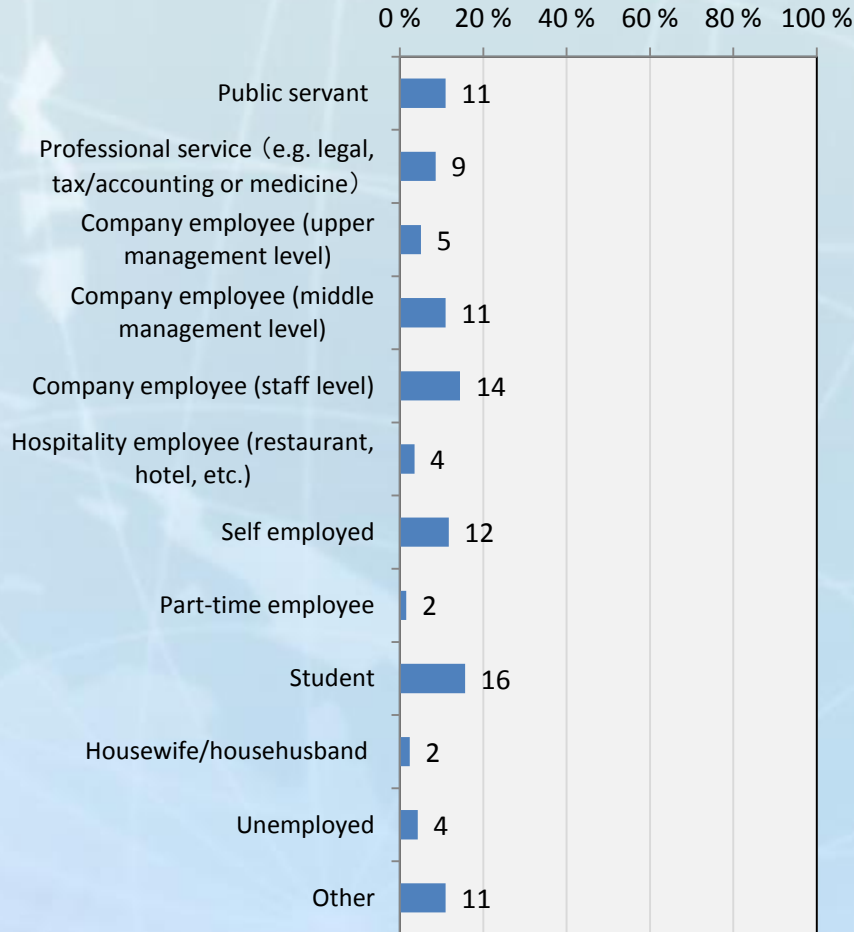
## S Areas of residence (SA)
